- Residential Grantee: A CAMP grantee that serves primarily students who live on campus.
- Four-Year Grantee Institution: A grantee institution that offers a four year, BA/BS degree to students.
- Two-Year Grantee Institution: A grantee institution that offers a two-year AA degree to students.
- CAMP Average: The mean score for all CAMP grantees.
- Cohort: All grantees funded within a given fiscal year (e.g., 2009 Cohort)






Chart 4. GPRA 2: Percent of 1st Yr. Completers Who Continue



Chart 5. Cost per 1st Yr. Completer




Chart 5 shows the cost per 1st Yr. Completer at California State University Long Beach Foundation and the average cost per 1st Yr. Completer at other types of grantees.

Chart 6. Efficiency Measure: Cost per 1st Year Completer Who Continues


