







The purpose of this report is to provide a “snapshot” of CAMP grantee basic information, performance measures, and funding data to stakeholders.

Definitions:

- Commuter Grantee: A CAMP grantee that serves primarily students who drive daily to school.
- Commuter/Residential Grantee: A CAMP grantee that serves both commuter and residential students.
- Residential Grantee: A CAMP grantee that serves primarily students who live on campus.
- Four-Year Grantee Institution: A grantee institution that offers a four year, BA/BS degree to students.
- Two-Year Grantee Institution: A grantee institution that offers a two-year AA degree to students.
- CAMP Average: The mean score for all CAMP grantees.
- Cohort: All grantees funded within a given fiscal year (e.g., 2009 Cohort)
